Archivaria is published twice a year and may be obtained by subscription or through membership in the Association of Canadian Archivists. Archivaria is available as a print or electronic subscription. Subscriptions are available to individuals as well as to institutions.

A downloadable subscription form with subscription rates may be viewed at http://www.archivists.ca/content/subscriber-services-archivaria or requested by contacting the ACA office at the address and numbers listed above. Taxes and delivery charges will vary depending on the mailing address of the subscriber, in Canada, in the USA, or outside of North America.

Open Access:

The full collection of published issues is available online at the *e-Archivaria* Main Collection link located at http://www.archivists.ca/content/e-archivaria. The eight (8) most recent issues are reserved for subscribers and ACA members.

Reprints & Back Issues:

1. Items in the Main Collection:

An article that appeared in Archivaria more than four years ago can be obtained on a selfserve basis at http://www.archivists.ca/content/e-archivaria, where articles are available free of charge.

A service order to the ACA office for one or more reprints from the Main Collection will be handled in the same manner as a comparable item requested from the Reserved Collection.

2. Items in the Reserved Collection:

For reprints of an article that appears in the Reserved Collection of *e-Archivaria*,

- a subscriber or ACA member can obtain articles at https://www.members-archivists.ca/.
- anyone without access to the Reserved Collection can request reprints in paper or electronic (PDF) format based on advance payment of the following fees:
 - o articles (includes Counterpoint, Studies in Documents, Notes & Communications, and review articles): \$25 each
 - all other items (including book and exhibition reviews): \$10 each.

3. Printed Back Issues:

Print copies of back issues of Archivaria published more than four years ago, and held in the Main Collection, are available at a cost of CDN \$10 each.

Print copies of back issues of Archivaria held in the Reserved Collection (published in the last four years) are available at a cost of CDN \$50 each.

Copies of the current issue are available at a prorated portion of the annual subscription fee. Note: a current issue is classified as a back issue when the subsequent issue goes into print production.

Postage fees for mailing of a single back issue are: \$5.00 Canada, \$10.00 USA, and \$15.00 international.

Orders must be pre-paid. Canadian taxes apply to orders delivered in Canada. Discounts apply on multiple copy orders. Please send your order with cheque or credit card information (MasterCard or VISA) to the ACA office.
